Please join us to hear about the 2016/2017 Raine Medical Research Foundation funding programmes including Grants, Fellowships, Research Collaboration Awards, Visiting Professor Awards and Publication Prizes.

The Raine Foundation has allocated in excess of \$36m for medical research since its inception in 1957, and currently commits in excess of \$1.3m for research programmes every year. These programmes are now **open to all medical researchers in Western Australia**, with specific eligibility criteria outlined in the Conditions for each programme.

This seminar will provide an overview of changes to the revised Conditions and, in particular, to the criteria governing candidate eligibility. It will highlight current partnership programs between the Raine Foundation and the WA Department of Health; and the BrightSpark Foundation. We will announce important dates for each programme and will outline relevant grant assessment processes. We will also provide information and instruction on our new website (rainefoundation.org.au) and the online application process, which will be launched in early February.
