The RETP aims to provide busy health practitioners with open access to comprehensive online research skills training across the entire research process

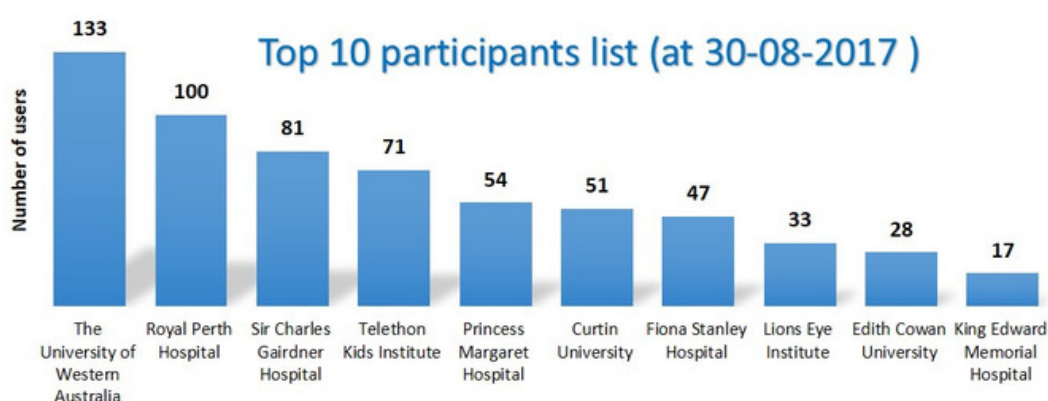

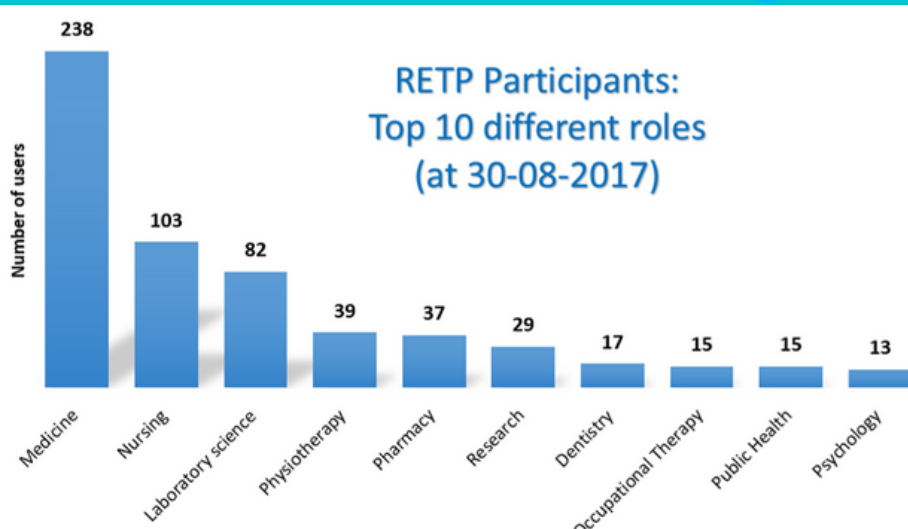
**100**

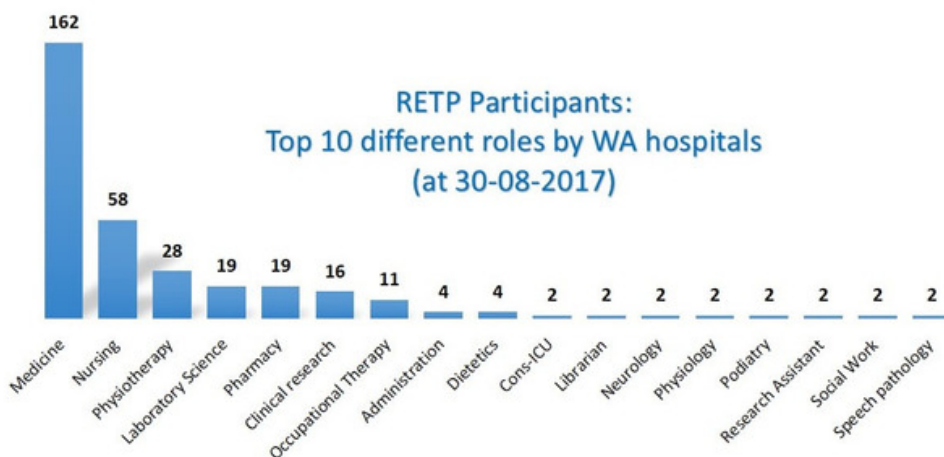
**150**

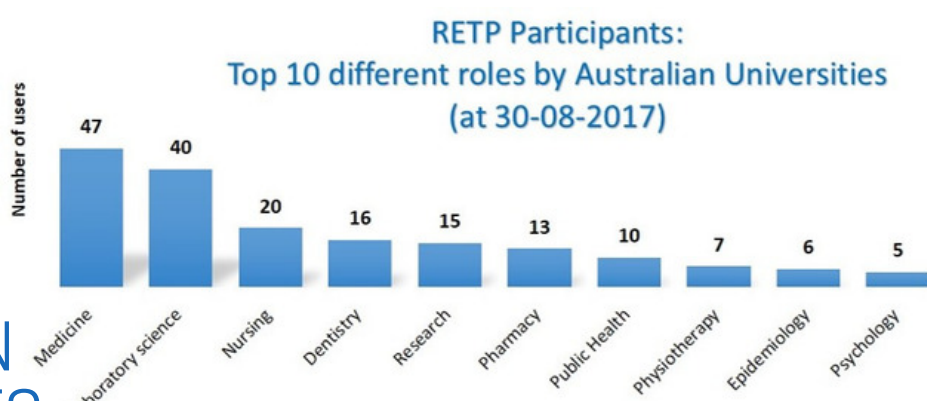
