## Professor Jeremy K. Nicholson

Formerly Head of Surgery and Cancer, Faculty of Medicine at Imperial College London, from October Pro Vice Chancellor at Murdoch University and leader of the new Australian National Phenome Centre (ANPC) based in Murdoch, WA.



The ANPC is a core platform of the WAHTN, involving collaborations between all WAHTN partners, including the five Universities in WA, the WA health research institutes, and the WA health department.

Following Professor Nicholson's address, an audience dialogue will be facilitated by Professor Peter Klinken AC, Chief Scientist of WA.

## *“Phenomenal Phenomics - placing WA at the centre of the globe”*

Changes in climate and population densities and distribution plus increasing socio-economic stresses placed on healthcare systems pose unique challenges in 21st Century medicine. A tension exists between the development of new investigative, diagnostic and prognostic technologies and the practical ability of scientists and healthcare professionals to deliver effective translational solutions and clinical actionability of this new knowledge.

With the advent of the new Australian National Phenome Centre (ANPC) based in Murdoch University and closely associated with the WAHTN partners we will develop new methodologies for patient diagnostics

and also address the problems of real-world actionability and clinical training. The ANPC will apply a range advanced measurement technologies to probe the origins of human disease and for understanding lifestyle and dietary factors that keep us healthy.

The ANPC is set to become one of the world's leading laboratories in the field, and by capitalising on its discoveries and working with international partners in the UK, Singapore and China we will create a range of new business opportunities in biomedicine and cognate research areas such as food science, nutrition and agriculture for Western Australia, the country and in the Asia-Pacific ring.
